### ***New DOD & GSA Cyber FAR & DFARS Requirements take effect December 31, 2017.***

Does your organization conduct business with the Federal Government or Department of Defense... even indirectly as a tier 2 thru 5? Effective December 31, 2017 new Supply Chain Cyber Security requirements become mandatory for all contacts and subcontracts at any tier.

The set of minimum cyber security standards are described in NIST Special Publication 800-171: Protecting Controlled Unclassified Information in Non-federal Information Systems and Organizations.

The requirements break down into fourteen areas:

1. Access Control
2. Awareness and Training
3. Audit & Accountability
4. Configuration Management
5. Identification & Authentication
6. Incident Response
7. Maintenance
8. Media Protection
9. Personnel Security
10. Physical Protection
11. Risk Assessment
12. Security Assessment
13. System & Communications Protection
14. System & Information Integrity
