Diseases like measles and pertussis (also know as whooping cough), once nearly eradicated, are flaring up in many states including Michigan. A new state policy in effect at the beginning of the year mandates that families who don't want to immunize their children can no longer get a waiver simply by mailing in a form. The modified rule requires non-medical exemptions to be certified by the local health department, which allows health workers to provide education on the safety of immunizations and potential consequences of going without them.
