The focus for the panel discussion is the dynamic relationship, both adversarial and cooperative, between the principal parties involved in a corporate investigation: the government (civil and criminal), the company, and the employees. The panelists include representatives from the United States Attorney's Office, the Federal Bureau of Investigation, corporate counsel, outside counsel representing the employee and a forensic investigative accountant. The program is presented by PricewaterhouseCoopers LLP and the University of Detroit Mercy School of Law.

He is a fellow of the American Bar Foundation and the Michigan State Bar Foundation. Mr. DuMouchel is a Fellow of the American College of Trial Lawyers and serves as a member of the criminal procedure and Michigan State Committees.

In 2004, Mr. DuMouchel, along with **Laurie J. Michelson**, gained their client's acquittal in one of the largest health care fraud trials in history in the U.S. District Court in Boston.

Mr. DuMouchel is a *cum laude* graduate of Wayne State University Law School (J.D., 1975) and the University of Detroit (M.A., 1972).
