Butzel Long attorney Reginald Pacis featured during Wayne State University Law First Generation Professionals TIPS Interview Panel

DETROIT, Mich. – Butzel Long immigration law attorney Reginald A. Pacis will be featured during Wayne State University's Law First Generation Professionals TIPS Interview Panel: Searching, Securing & Sticking the Interview" on September 21, 2017.

Pacis is co-chair of Butzel Long's Summer Associate Recruiting Committee and serves on the Lateral Attorney Recruiting Committee. Pacis is a member of the American Bar Association, the American Immigration Lawyers Association (AILA), and the Samahang Pilipino Ng Oakland Filipino organization. He served two consecutive one-year terms from 2003 to 2005 as Chairperson of the Michigan Chapter of AILA and was a member of the AILA National Board of Governors for those terms. Pacis previously served as Secretary (2001 to 2003) and Membership Chairperson of the Michigan Chapter of AILA (1998 to 2003).
