Butzel Long attorney featured during Flint & Genesee Chamber of Commerce program on January 20, 2016

DETROIT, Mich. – Daniel B. Tukul, a labor and employment attorney with Butzel Long, will conduct a training session during a Flint & Genesee Chamber of Commerce program on Wednesday, January 20, 2016 at Baker College in Flint.

His presentation is titled, "The Most Often and Repeated Labor and Employment Mistakes Employers Make." This is the first in a series of quarterly training sessions featuring Butzel Long labor and employment attorneys in 2016.
