Among the numerous provisions of this comprehensive bill was the creation of the "COVID-related Tax Relief Act of 2020," which made several changes to the PPP structure and the "Economic Aid to Hard-Hit Small Businesses, Nonprofits, and Venues Act," which established a much-needed second round of PPP funding.
