## Butzel attorney Beth Gotthelf appointed Chair of the Michigan Manufacturers Association Environmental Policy Committee

She also has guided members through the many challenging PFAS impacts in the facility, air, wastewater, stormwater, and soil, not to mention the financial challenges.
