# Butzel donates nearly 400 backpacks filled with school supplies to K-5 students at Oakman Elementary School in Dearborn

Importantly, studies indicate that students who have the proper supplies they need for school obtain better grades and higher test scores.

"Studies also indicate that when students have the supplies they need, their attendance improves, which also leads to better performance," he added. "Just as important, by providing students with materials they need for school, we can help parents and families make ends meet and ensure they do not have to choose between purchasing school supplies and purchasing food, clothing, and other essential needs. Moreover, many teachers pay for supplies out of pocket, and this also helps them. Our teachers have a very important job, and anything we can do to help them is an added benefit."
