Notably, updated OEM terms and conditions are included in the 2023 edition of the “OEM Light Vehicle North American Production Purchase Order Contract Terms and Conditions Comparative Analysis” publication. It will be available at a discount with event registration, at the event, and through the end of the day on September 27, 2023.

The publication compares the terms and conditions of BMW, Ford Motor Company, General Motors, Honda, Hyundai, Kia, Lucid, Mazda, Mercedes, Rivian, Scout, Stellantis, Toyota, Volkswagen and Volvo. The new edition addresses updates for BMW, Honda and Mercedes. In addition, for the first time, it includes the Mazda terms (Mazda Motors of America, Inc. Master Sales and Purchase Agreement, 08/11/20) and the Scout Motor terms (Scout Motors, Inc. Production Terms and Conditions of Purchase, January 27, 2023).
