Steve Moore and Keti Mebuke Explore Legal and Ethical Challenges for Health Providers Adopt COVID-19 Triage Protocols

Hinshaw's Steve Moore and Keti Mebuke authored a *Law360* expert analysis titled "COVID-19 Triage Rules Raise Dilemmas For Health Providers." In the article, they discuss COVID-19 triage guidelines being adopted by hospitals and states across the U.S. that have come under scrutiny because of the legal and ethical challenges they pose for health care providers.

In their examination of specific triage guidelines, the authors note that disability advocates have filed a "significant number of complaints" with the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services.
