Hinshaw Insurance Law Television: A Review of 2021's Most Significant Insurance Coverage Decisions and Cases to Watch in 2022

- COVID-19 business interruption and civil authority insurance coverage (in 2021, there were approximately 2,100 COVID-19-related cases filed in federal and state courts across the country)
- Cyber/privacy
- recoupment
- legal malpractice
- priority of coverage among policies

Among the many cases to watch in 2022, are opioid coverage disputes and an important issue before the Texas Supreme Court regarding looking to extrinsic evidence to determine a duty to defend.
