So I would go there at night and the nuns would come and visit me and bring me food. The first time, two nuns came in and said, 'What are you doing?' I explained myself, and then they would come visit every night and when they left they'd say, 'We're all praying for you.' So I'm thinking, 'This is great. I've got the nuns praying for me.'"
