Former Consumer Fraud Enforcement Attorney Joins Hinshaw in Chicago

Previously an Assistant Attorney General for the Office of the Illinois Attorney General, where she served as a supervising attorney in the Consumer Fraud Bureau, Rao will join the firm's Consumer Financial Services group. She will focus her practice on regulatory compliance counseling—especially with unfair, deceptive and abusive consumer protection laws—across financial services industries including loan servicing and debt management, as well as in the health care industry.

She also led the largest national investigation into student loan origination, servicing and debt collection practices, in concert with other state Attorneys General. She worked with Federal agencies on negotiations that resulted in a \$25 billion mortgage servicing settlement with the nation's five largest servicers. She is very familiar with agency personnel at the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (CFPB), the Federal Trade Commission (FTC), and also at the state regulatory level.

"I'm looking forward to helping clients manage their exposure to government actions and navigate complex regulatory requirements that can be challenging for businesses to implement," said Rao. "With the current uncertainty of federal regulation across many industry sectors, state Attorneys General will play an even greater role in policing the marketplace. I intend to use my experience in consumer protection to help clients develop compliance strategies that can significantly reduce the risk of government enforcement."

Rao is a graduate of The John Marshall Law School (J.D.) and the University of Pittsburgh (B.S.B.A, B.A.). She is admitted to practice in Illinois and the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Illinois.
