

DACO ALERT November 2, 2009

New Sweepstakes Regulation

The Department of Consumer Affairs (DACO) issued a new Sweepstakes Regulation that will be effective on November 26, 2009. This new Regulation amended the August 1998 Regulation in many aspects but the main amendments are the following:

- The language of the contest rules can now be in Spanish and/or English;
- The definition of "consideration" was expanded;
- The 30 day notification provision is no longer mandatory;
- The certification requirement was eliminated;
- The notary requirements were eliminated;
- The publication requirements were expanded -now the rules can be published through the Internet;
- The distinction between Puerto Rican promotions and national promotions was eliminated.
