Last week McV's Antonio J. Ramírez-Aponte and Sila M. González-Calderón delivered a presentation titled *Legislative Developments in the Insurance Industry in Puerto Rico* at the annual luncheon and meeting of the Puerto Rico Chapter of the CPCU Society.
