On December 18, 2018, the Puerto Rico Public-Private Partnership Authority (the "Authority") published and opened a public comment period for its proposed *Guidelines for the Preparation, Evaluation, Selection, and Procurement of Public Private Partnerships through Unsolicited Proposals* (the "Guidelines").

The purpose of these Guidelines is to establish a three stage process for the preparation, evaluation, selection and procurement of Public-Private Partnerships initiated as Unsolicited Proposals detailed in Section 9(b)(ii) of Act No. 29-2009, as amended, and Section 7 of the Regulation for the Procurement, Evaluation, Selection, Negotiation and Award of Participatory Public-Private Partnership Contracts.

The deadline for submitting comments is January 3, 2019 on or before 5:00 p.m. (AST).
