

State Medical Investigations

In recent years, there has been a significant increase in investigations conducted by the Boards of Medicine and the Attorney General's Office.

Although these investigations are typically not covered by insurance, physicians and other health care providers should NEVER respond to a state investigation without the advice and counsel of an attorney who specializes in this area of practice. Potential ramifications of such investigations can have far-reaching effects on an individual's medical license and may result in significant monetary sanctions.
