He initiated Medicaid fraud civil recoveries, prosecuted Medicaid provider fraud, prosecuted financial abuse in resident care facilities, represented the state in Qui Tam cases filed by whistleblowers under the Medicaid False Claims Act, and he served on national teams with other Qui Tam states to investigate and prosecute global fraud cases.

Mr. Schroder also has extensive experience in governmental law, having served as an assistant city attorney for the city of Warren for approximately nine years. While there, he represented the city in litigation and court proceedings; negotiated and recommended contracts for consideration and approval; prosecuted criminal cases, including warrant authorization and bench/jury trials; represented the city's planning commission, library commission, and brownfield authority; researched and responded to Freedom of Information Act requests; drafted city ordinances and resolutions; drafted legal opinions for elected officials and department heads; and worked
