- Successfully defended to no cause for action many claims relating to ectopic pregnancies against emergency medicine physicians, family practice physicians and obstetricians/gynecologists.

 in a myocardial infarction while driving an automobile causing the

 convincing trial courts to hold *Daubert* hearings (evidentiary hearings which test the scientific
 reliability of a proffered theory) and has prevailed at such hearings.
- <u>Dispositive Motions</u>: An aggressive litigator, Ms. Andreou constantly looks for ways to obtain early
 dismissal of a case and has prevailed in having dozens of cases dismissed based on successful
 challenges to the statute of limitations, expert qualifications and proximate cause.
