Specifically, panelists will:

- Analyze extant gambling laws and regulations and predict how they may be applied to new entertainment and sports business models in the online marketplace
- Illustrate how difficult it may be to apply laws enacted in the 20th century under different societal circumstances, to 21st century media and technology
- Explain how legal authorities in various jurisdictions treat similar fact patterns differently because of heterogeneous cultural norms.
