As part of his work, he moved to India for several months. He joined the True team in 2008.

Puneet holds a BS and MS in Industrial Engineering from Stanford University, where he was also a Mayfield Fellow. When he is not busy working with exciting entrepreneurs at True, you can find him navigating life with his wife and two children.
