In addition to high-profile clients such as musician Danny Elfman and singer Gloria Trevi, Vasquez is currently representing producers Amanda Ghost, Gregor Cameron and Vince Holden in a lawsuit against actress Rebel Wilson.

"I think that all of the cases that I tend to work on are high-profile with a lot of public interest, and with that comes pros and cons," Vasquez said. "There's always scrutiny since the cases involve issues that society has a lot of strong opinions on."
