

Judge Tosses Trump-Era Pebble Mine Approval in Bristol Bay

Bloomberg Law reports the EPA can take a second look at its decision to withdraw proposed pollution limits for the Pebble Mine in Alaska's Bristol Bay region, a federal court in the state said in a ruling that vacated the agency's action.
