DRAFTING

As experienced practitioners, we realize that advancement of the patent application may often be best facilitated by conducting an interview with the patent examiner in order to crystallize, and often resolve, any outstanding issues in an application. As with the initial drafting of the patent application, our attorneys continue to consult with the inventor so that any resulting patent

provides the desired protection for the innovation.
