The *Kansas City Star* [recently quoted](#) partner [Gerald Weidner](#) as he shared insight for business owners on qualification for the program and how to seek funds to continue to pay their employees.

“Like any other government program, nothing is easy on these programs,” said Gerald. “The statute was enacted very quickly, signed into law very quickly.” Borrowers don’t have to prove that they have lost money due to the pandemic or can’t obtain financing elsewhere. “Just that you’ve been affected by the economic uncertainty of the pandemic,” he said.
