Missouri Appleseed is an independent nonprofit organization that champions the rights of society's most vulnerable populations. Their mission is to develop solutions to community problems with a goal of providing all Missourians an opportunity to live healthy, dignified and productive lives. Through advocacy, education and research, Missouri Appleseed works on issues at the intersection of criminal justice reform and public health.

Scavotto has assisted Missouri Appleseed with a variety of research and policy projects ranging from efforts to expand access to criminal expungement, driver's license reinstatement and access to visitation with minor children for incarcerated parents. Since 2017, Scavotto has donated 163 hours to Missouri Appleseed.
