They highlight ongoing cases against major tech companies, including Amazon, Apple, Google and Meta, and emphasize that these cases are expected to continue, even amid shifts in federal enforcement priorities. The attorneys also explore the growing interests and influence of state attorneys general in pursuing monopolization and merger challenges, which they note could lead to significant changes in antitrust doctrine. The impact of emerging theories and policies related to diversity, equity and inclusion and environmental, social and governance matters on competition are also addressed.

"The outcomes and remedies that result will likely reshape antitrust doctrine beyond the tech industry," the attorneys write. "Successful theories are expected to lead to an increase in antitrust litigation by governments, both state and federal, as well as private parties."
