The story states: "The newest generation of technology tackles the volume by doing much more than plucking out documents with keywords. With some coaching by an attorney, the software can learn what's relevant to a case and rank documents accordingly. 'With the latent semantic indexing, it looks at the relationship of all the words within a document. An example is if you searched for 'Julie Brown,' you would probably get documents that have 'litigation technology' in them but don't have my name,' [Brown] said."
