Ohio House of Representatives Honors Stratton's Judicial Career

Evelyn Lundberg Stratton, of counsel in the Vorys Columbus office, was honored by the Ohio House of Representatives on May 7, 2013. State Representative Mike Duffey, from Ohio's 21st House District, presented Stratton with a certificate acknowledging her 16 years of service as a Justice on the Supreme Court of Ohio. The certificate also acknowledged her achievements as the first female judge of the Franklin County Common Pleas Court and her work on behalf of adults and children with mental illness in the criminal justice system.
