William G. Porter, II was honored on June 23, 2010 for his years of service as chairman of the Board of the Central Ohio Transit Authority (COTA) with the dedication of a new boardroom in his honor. Porter II Boardroom will also be available to host the meetings of other organizations. Porter served as chairman of the Board from 2002 through 2009.
