Eve Stratton, of counsel in the Vorys Columbus office who prior to joining Vorys was a justice on the Supreme Court of Ohio, was the subject of an article in the Spring 2021 edition of the *Columbus Bar Lawyers Quarterly* titled "Lawyers With Artistic License." Eve has, however, continued to pursue other creative outlets, including crafting birthday and special occasion cakes. She began making theme cakes for each son's birthday. The themes have ranged over the years from teddy bears and trains to lightsabers, shields and swords. Eve bakes the cakes in square or round pans, and then cuts and pieces the shapes together to create her desired form. She finishes them off with decorative frosting and icings, considering them 'definitely home-made.'"
