'You should protect against the possibility of 'friendly fire.' Now that the U.S. Patent Office uses a first to file system, it is at least possible that your company's supposed ally (vendor, customer, technology collaborator) can take your technology/improvement (in whole or in part) and include the same in its own confidential patent application without your knowledge. Also, if your company's innovation is not protected by IP, it is possible that your customer could seek other sourcing for a product you created.
