## Ziance Quoted in “Former Dispatch Headquarters Seeks Place on Historic Register”

Scott Ziance, a partner in the Columbus office, was quoted in a *Columbus Dispatch* story regarding the application for historic designation that was filed by the owners of the Dispatch building at 34 S. 3rd St., in Columbus.

**The story states:**

*“The company wants the building on the Columbus Register of Historic Places. It also is considering filing an application to be placed on the National Register of Historic Places.*

*Being placed on the Columbus register would qualify the building to be considered for Ohio historic tax credits, a competitive process, said Scott Ziance, who has represented Columbus developer Casto as tax-credit counsel. Being placed on the national register would qualify it for federal credits as well. The federal process is not competitive.”*
