- India's government has extended the lockdown until May 3, 2020. E-filing modules of the IP office remains fully functional for all new filings/submission of documents.
- New Zealand (IPONZ) has released a new [online form](#) to more efficiently answer questions and concerns. Extension of deadlines will be handled on a case-by-case basis.
- UAE has announced a wide range of [fee reductions](#) intended to support local and foreign companies affected by COVID-19.
- Other general closures & deadline extensions have been added to the document.
