

Represented insurer in one of the first reported decisions on coverage under a media/special perils policy with a decision subsequently affirmed by the Illinois Supreme Court

Represented D&O insurer in Delaware action obtaining ruling for the Delaware Supreme Court granting insurance summary judgment of no coverage
