

White and Williams Secures Seven-Figure Subrogation Settlement Following a Water Leak in a Residential Tower

A commercial developer hired a general contractor to build an apartment building complex. The general contractor hired a mechanical contractor to install the plumbing systems. Near final completion, a plumbing solder joint failed causing a significant water loss. White and Williams partner Chris Konzelmann - assisted by counsel Bill Doerler - led the subrogation investigation and successfully negotiated a multi-million dollar pre-lawsuit settlement.
