



Public-Private Partnerships and the President's Infrastructure Draft Bill

Earlier this year, President Trump released his long-awaited infrastructure plan (the "Plan").The 53page document can be found here. Among other things in the Plan, the President expressly requested that Congress act on an "infrastructure bill that will stimulate at least \$1.5 trillion in new investment over the next 10 years." By infrastructure, the President means more than traditional infrastructure, e.g., roads, bridges, and airports, but also drinking and waste-water systems, waterways, water resources, energy, rural infrastructure, public lands, veterans' hospitals, and Brownfield and Superfund sites.
