On Tuesday, May 13th from 8:00am-3:00pm New York's asset management leaders and the professionals who support them will gather for the inaugural ISO 55000 Conference for the U.S. The conference will bring together real estate and infrastructure asset management experts at Baruch College's William and Anita Newman Conference Center to discuss how the ISO 55000 has changed the understanding of asset management and broadened the array of activities associated with the field.

Salvato, Executive Program Manager of Enterprise Asset Management, focusing on the industry implications of the ISO 55000. The panelists include Linda Aronson, Managing Director of JLL, Terry D. Bennett, Senior Industry Program Manager of Autodesk, Inc., Nancy Johnson, Senior Program Manager of the Port Authority of New York & New Jersey, and Michael S. Zetlin, Senior Partner of Zetlin & De Chiara LLP.
